HELPS TUTORING INAUGURAL YEAR This past school year, Read Charlotte partnered with CMS and other organizations to launch HELPS tutoring to provide targeted fluency tutoring to 155 third graders in ten elementary schools, including Montclaire. Organizations, including SAPC, partnered to recruit volunteer tutors. The bottom line is the results of this high-impact opportunity exceeded expectations. In fact, 46% of the 155 students exceeded the normal amount of growth that occurs for third graders.
