



**LET'S MAKE THIS THE SUMMER OF LOVE!** In the Gospel of John, after the resurrection, Jesus shared breakfast with his disciples.

After the meal, Jesus asked Peter if he loved him. Peter responded, "Yes, LORD, you know I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep." Like Peter, we love Jesus; and so we seek to feed his children.

In Sunday School our children have been busily studying Jesus' command to feed his sheep. We made lemon pies for our CDC teachers and gathered to sort food to share with children at Montclaire Elementary School, who are registered in the nutritional program and are at risk of hunger during the summer months.

Families with infants through children age four brought in 11 boxes of cereal and 23 boxes of fruit cups; kindergarteners and first graders brought in 12 boxes of wheat crackers and 13 boxes of fruit chews; second and third graders brought in 16 boxes of granola bars, 24 non-refrigerated microwavable meals, and 8 bags of nuts; fourth and fifth graders brought in 50 cans of tuna and 42 boxed pasta dinners.

Lemonade on the lawn is back! Families of rising third, fourth and fifth graders are invited to man the lemonade table after worship Sundays, now until September. Duties include: making the lemonade, taking it out to the provided table on the lawn, and serving our thirsty guests and members.
